Pillar Jax Preaching Overview

Guiding Passages

Ezra 7:10- The preacher's life is to know the Law of the Lord, apply it in his own life, and teach others. **Nehemiah 8:8-** The preacher's aim is a faithful reading, give the sense, that the people understand. **Luke 24:13-27; 44-49-** The preacher's aim is to preach Christ as the primary focus of the entire Bible.

2 Timothy 2:15- The preacher's primary judge is God Himself in how he handles the Word.

2 Timothy 3- The preacher's audience will include people who will not listen.

2 Timothy 4- The preacher's well from which he draws is the Bible first, foremost, and always.

2 Timothy 2:1-2- The preacher's legacy will be generations of faithful men.

Overall Goals

Expository Peaching- We preach the main point of the passage as the main point of the sermon. **Preach Entire Books of the Bible-** We don't skip passages.

The Whole Counsel of God- We aim to preach multiple books in multiple genres over a 3-year period. Prefer the New Testament- We spend more time and thoroughness in the New Testament.

Plurality of Preachers-

1) Builds the church on the Word- not a personality.

2) Trains new preachers (making disciples who make disciples).

3) Prepares for multiplication.

4) Bridges the "clergy/laity divide".

Roles and Responsibilities

Training Preacher-

Trains and equips preachers for the work of the ministry. Provides regular feedback for preachers.

Seeks out opportunities for preachers.

Preacher-

Preach the Word faithfully.

Continually improve your craft.

Preacher in Training-

Learn to study and prepare. Learn to deliver. Learn to continually improve.

Helpful Resources

Fellow Preachers- Receive and provide encouragement and correction from/to one another **Congregation-** Solicit feedback from our hearers from various demographics- military, civilian, men, women, youth, elderly, etc.

Preacher's Talk Podcast- Listen to these men from the Simeon Trust who think, talk, and write about preaching as a full-time and lifelong commitment.

Good Books on Preaching- The expectation is that each preacher will read at least 1 book on preaching each year.
