## Child Rearing Lesson

### Introduction

Minnesota Crime Commission said this:

“Every baby starts life as a little savage. He is completely selfish and self-centered. He wants what he wants, when he wants it; his bottle, his mother’s attention, his playmate’s toys, his uncle’s watch.
