WHY SAN ANTONIO?

- 1. San Antonio is growing.** With the population expected to swell by 20% to 1.8 Million by the year 2030, San Antonio is one of the fastest growing cities in one of the fastest growing states in the U.S. Many of these new residents are moving from highly unchurched parts of the country such as California, Oregon, and New York. This growth is creating a tremendous need for new churches to be planted to keep up with the expanding population.
- 2. San Antonio is Military City, USA.** San Antonio is home to 3 military installations which together comprise Joint Base San Antonio. Over 35,000 active duty service members serve across these three installations. Additionally, the San Antonio area is home to around 100,000 veterans. One local Baptist denominational leader said, “Churches here really struggle to reach the military”. Since it already takes the average service member 6 months to find a church home in a new location, the need here is great!



3. San Antonio is a natural church planting hub.

We envision planting multiple churches in military communities in and around Texas, starting with San Antonio as the hub. Texas has the third highest military population in the country with 124,000 active duty service members. We want to train and equip leaders to plant multiplying churches focused on reaching the military near Fort Hood (Killeen) [89,000 active duty and dependents], Fort Bliss (El Paso) [78,500 active duty and dependents], Dyess AFB (Abilene) [13,130 active duty and dependents], and Naval Air Station Corpus Christi [43,000 active duty and dependents]. And that is just the beginning!




★ PROJECTED **TIMELINE** ★



BUDGET

By supporting our annual budget, you are helping us live, gather, send, and shepherd in San Antonio and beyond.



HELP US LIVE

Salary + Benefits: \$136,800 (51% of budget)

HELP US GATHER

Operations: \$51,000 (19% of budget)

Missions & Church Planting: \$50,000 (18% of budget)
