John Turner

John is an Air Force retiree and holds an MDiv from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He served as an associate pastor at Village Parkway Baptist Church in San Antonio, TX for over six years when God called him into church planting. He resigned from Village Parkway BC and joined Pillar Church of San Antonio a few months before the church launched in March 2023. However, in August 2023, God sent John and his wife, Angie, on a vision trip to Killeen, TX, and over the next six months, gave them a clear sense that Killeen was where He wanted them to plant a church. In obedience to God, John and Angie moved to Killeen in June 2024, settling in Harker Heights. They were married in 1997 and have three children: Georgia, Diego, and Caleb.



Jerimiah Walker

Jerimiah came to know the Lord at the age of 6 and enlisted in the US Army in 2000. He attended THE Ohio State University where he met his wife, Shelli, who he married after graduation in 2005. He served as an elder at Harmony Baptist Church in Waynesville, MO for 2 years. He has been in the Fort Cavazos area since 2019, and served as an elder at Christ Community Church in Harker Heights, TX for 4 years. Jerimiah and Shelli have 3 children: Madison, Alex, and Jace. They have a heart for military communities as he will finish 20 years of service in 2025.

WHY KILLEEN, TX?

1. Killeen is growing.

Like every city in Texas, Killeen is growing. Killeen's population has grown by 23.23% since 2010, and is expected to grow to 1.4% annually reaching 185,000 by 2034.


2. Killeen is home of the 3rd largest military installation in the US.

Ft. Cavazos (formerly Ft. Hood) is home of the US Army's III Armored Corps, which is the world's premier mounted force, deployable to anywhere in the world while regularly rotating to Europe and Asia.

3. Killeen has a need for healthy churches.

With the growing population and constant transition in this military community, there is a significant need for more Gospel preaching churches, especially those who are targeting the underserved military culture.

"According to the US Census Bureau, Killeen is the nation's most affordable and fastest growing city; with a 5 year growth rate of almost 10%. Even if every church in Killeen was orthodox, healthy, and growing there would not be enough churches to meet the growing demand of the city and the demand is great. Located next to Ft. Cavazos, one of America's largest military installations, the stresses of military life combined with America's epidemic of loneliness and isolation creates an environment of hopelessness. Killeen needs churches that proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ, that create biblical and faithful communities, to bring hope to the darkness in which the city finds itself." - Stephen Watson, Pastor of Christ Community Church




★ PROJECTED TIMELINE ★
