31 Days of Prayer for the Military and the Praetorian Project

01. November 11

Pray for God to bless and guide military members and their families to be instruments of His peace and love, like Cornelius in Acts 10.

02. November 12

Pray that God would use the movement and transitions of military life as His divine strategy to advance the gospel through the Praetorian Project and its churches.

03. November 13

Pray for a hunger for God's Word and for faithful, fruitful expository preaching to transform military members, families, and communities.

04. November 14

Pray for military members to be discipled through engaged churches, Christlike leadership, to have strong faith amid distractions, and for many to live as missionaries within their units.

05. November 15

Pray for churches to intentionally support and disciple military spouses through constant change by meeting practical needs, praying, and sharing the gospel.

06. November 16

Pray for God to call, equip, and raise up retiring military believers to serve as pastors, church planters, and missionaries in their communities.

07. November 17

Pray and ask: God, how will you use me to minister to military service members and their families?

08. November 18

Pray for our pastors and future pastors to be well-trained to preach the Word of God with discernment and wisdom.

09. November 19

Pray for the pastors of the Praetorian Project to be strengthened, protected, and encouraged as they faithfully lead, fight the good fight, and pursue Christ.

10. November 20

Pray for the wives of Praetorian Project pastors to be strengthened, cared for, and equipped to support their families, husbands, and the work of church ministry.

11. November 21

Pray for pastors' kids to grow up with joy and strong faith, finding deep family bonds and life-giving friendships as they experience life in ministry.

12. November 22

Pray that pastors and their families remain vigilant against Satan's schemes, resist temptation, rely on God's strength, and persevere in faith until Christ's ultimate victory over evil is fully revealed.

13. November 23

Pray for pastors to form strong partnerships and relationships for support in the mission so they are not alone in their endeavors to reach military communities.

14. November 24

Pray and ask: God, how will you use me to encourage and support pastors who are planting churches in military communities?

15. November 25

Pray with gratitude for God's faithfulness in expanding the Praetorian Project and ask for His continued wisdom, unity, and provision as new churches are planted in military communities worldwide.

16. November 26

Pray for the Praetorian Project to boldly take the gospel to major military hub communities, that hearts would be prepared and workers raised up for the harvest.

17. November 27

Pray for deployed service members and their families to experience God's protection, peace, and presence this season, and for many to come to know Christ even while far from home.

18. November 28

Pray that Marines and their families in 29 Palms would find strength, joy, and hope in Christ as they face the challenges of military life and grow in faith within loving church communities.

19. November 29

Pray for the people of Norfolk and its many Navy families to find lasting peace in Christ, and for Pillar Church of Norfolk to shine His light in a city rich with opportunity yet hungry for renewal.

20. November 30

Pray for God's wisdom and provision for a Pillar Church to be planted and established in Northwest Washington state, and for those who will lead it.

21. December 1

Pray for Washington, D.C., that its leaders, citizens, and service members would find their true identity in Christ, and that Pillar DC would be a faithful light advancing the gospel throughout the city.

22. December 2

Pray for gospel advancement in the Air Force through new church plants, ministry opportunities, and community groups in bases like Lackland AFB in San Antonio.

23. December 3

Pray for Pillar Church of Fayetteville, NC, to grow in strength and unity as they reach the soldiers and families of Fort Bragg with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

24. December 4

Pray for the military community in Okinawa, Japan to find deep gospel-centered relationships, strengthened marriages, and unity in Christ as they grow together in faith far from home.

25. December 5

Pray for a recent church plant, Pillar Killeen, to grow in unity, wisdom, and love as they share the hope of Jesus with the people of Killeen and Fort Hood.

26. December 6

Pray and ask: God, how will you use me to support the church planting efforts of the Praetorian Project?

27. December 7

Pray that young military men and women would embrace gospel-centered ministry as their mission, be faithfully trained and encouraged, and remain steadfast amid the challenges of military life.

28. December 8

Pray for military believers to remain strong and courageous, serving as faithful ambassadors of Christ while making disciples and reflecting His love wherever they are stationed.

29. December 9

Pray for Christian veterans to discern God's call to gospel ministry and that it may come with spiritual growth, family support, church encouragement, and clear guidance.

30. December 10

Pray and ask: God, how will you use me to support Christians in the military living on mission for the gospel?

31. December 11

Pray that God uses our collective prayers to unite our hearts, guide our steps, and empower us to advance the Gospel boldly.
